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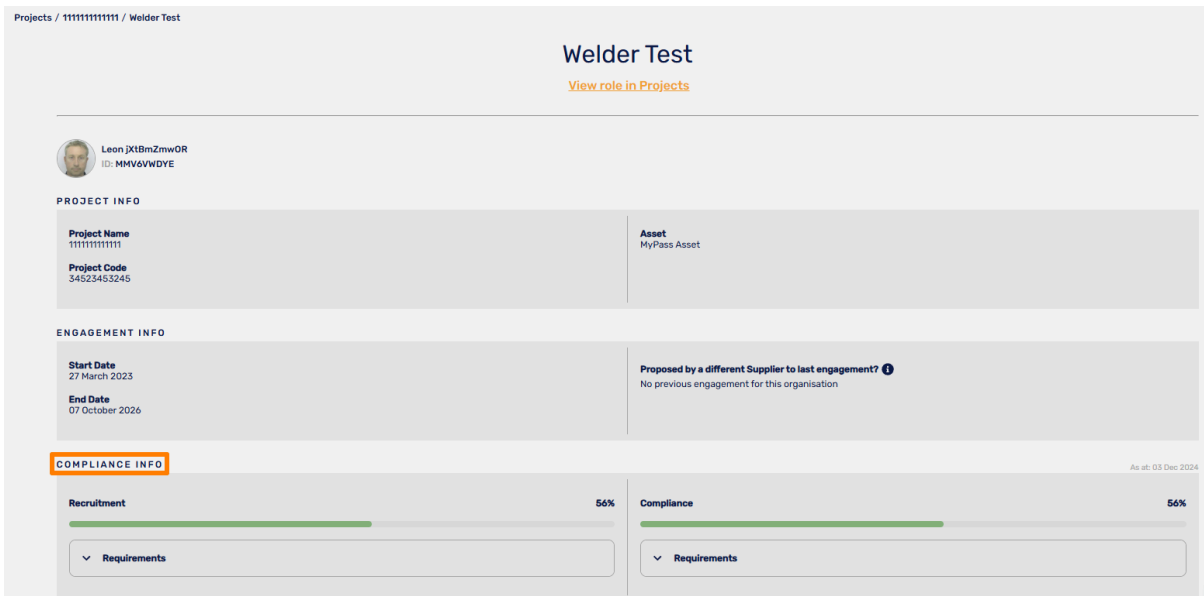
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## Enhancements

### View Worker Compliance in the Project & Role details screen

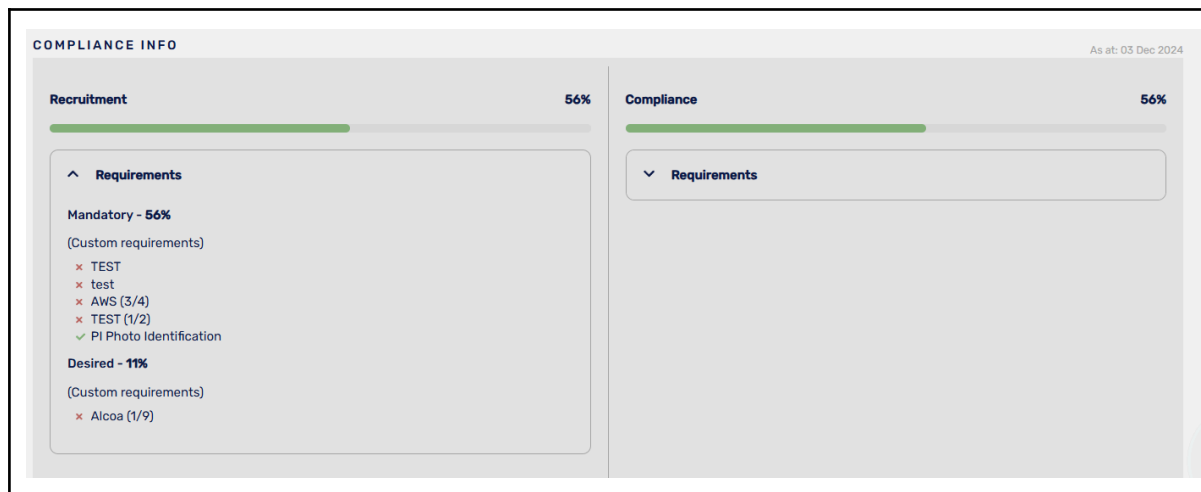
Hiring clients can now view comprehensive compliance details from the Project & Role Details Screen screen for both proposed and confirmed workers.

Selecting a worker from the Project role screen will open the worker's profile in the same way, however when a user selects the role from the profile, opening Project & Role details screen the 'Compliance Info' section will now be included in the display.

This feature enables users to identify compliance gaps for a Project role, facilitating more efficient follow-ups with Supplier administrators.

## Simplified Personnel Certifications Export

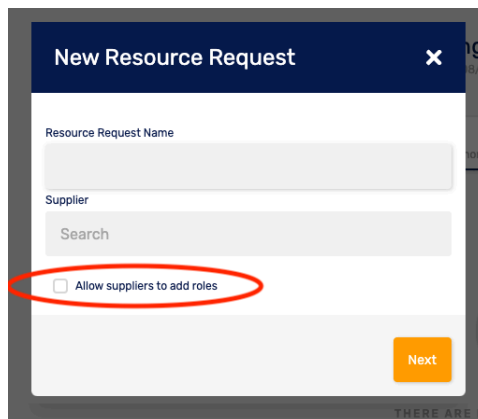
Industry portal users can now download a simplified version of worker certification exports, reducing the need for manual adjustments in Excel. The email notification sent to users will include an additional download link titled *Personnel Certifications (Simplified)*.

This export provides the most recent or relevant attainment (determined by existing logic) for each certification that a worker has. The exported data is streamlined to include the following fields;

- firstName
- lastName
- classifications
- positions
- certificationCode
- certificationName
- status
- issueDate
- expiryDate

## Mandatory Role Positions for Supplier Created Roles

Today, Supplier Administrators can add project roles to a Hiring Client's project if the Hiring Client enables this option when sending the Resource Request. This allows suppliers to define the necessary roles and compliance positions required to mobilize their workforce for the specified scope of work (project)

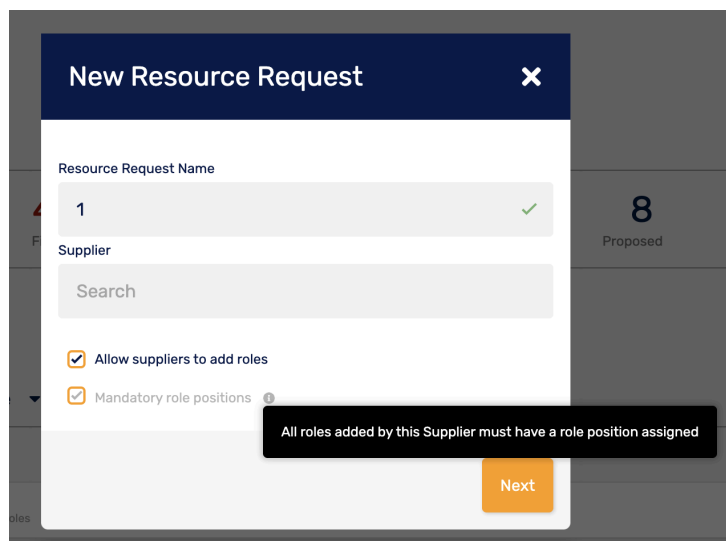

With the recent introduction of the *Mandatory Role Positions* feature, we have expanded its scope to include Supplier-created roles. This enhancement allows Hiring Clients to enforce that suppliers define roles with at least one position, ensuring baseline compliance requirements are met for all created roles

Here, when the 'Allow suppliers to add roles' option is selected during the creation of a new resource request, the 'Mandatory Role Positions' option will also become available.



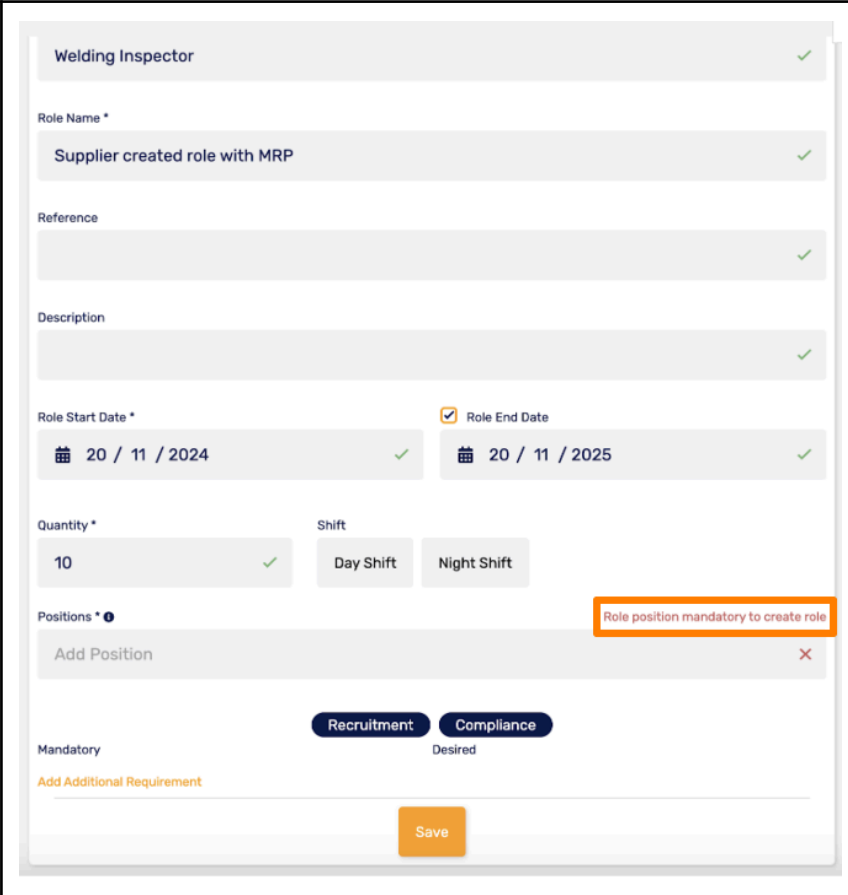

Note, If the 'Mandatory Role Position' feature is enabled for your organisation, the 'Mandatory Role Positions' checkbox will be selected by default and cannot be toggled off. This ensures that all supplier-created roles include at least one position

Alternatively, if the 'Mandatory Role Position' feature is not enabled, the checkbox will be editable, allowing users to choose whether to enable or disable this requirement for supplier-created roles.

As a result, if mandatory role positions are enforced for supplier created roles, and Supplier admin tries to 'Save' without adding a position, the error message 'Role position mandatory' is displayed.

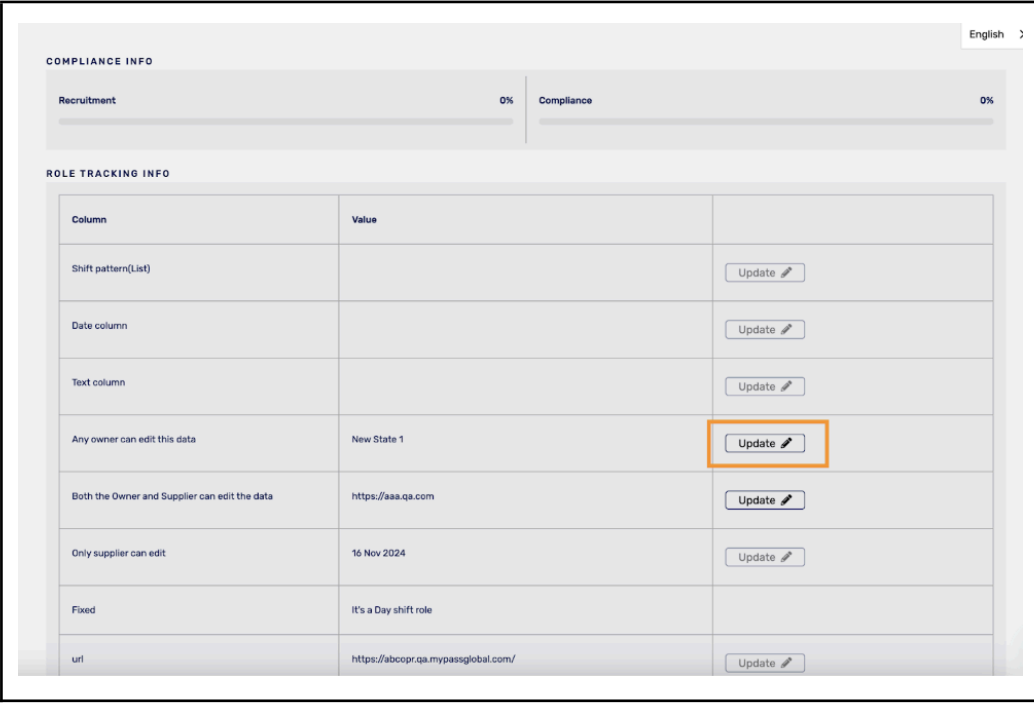

## Asset Information added to the roleWorkerProposed Webhook

Asset information is now included in the 'roleWorkerProposed' Webhook within the Project attribute. This modification allows external systems to receive immediate notifications about the relevant asset when a worker is proposed, providing a crucial reference for subsequent decision-making and actions.

## Update the RTT Column in the Extended Role View

Updates to the RTT column can now be made within the 'Project & Role details screen', eliminating the need to navigate away from the role. The streamlining of this process will enhance efficiency and ease of role management.

The ability to make these updates is controlled by permissions. These can include;

- Hiring client without user group restrictions allowing anyone within the organisation to edit the value
- Hiring client with user group restrictions, limiting ability to edit to only the users within that group
- Supplier admin, restricting Hiring client admins from updating
- Both, allowing Hiring client & Supplier admins to edit

## Restored Language Translation Option
